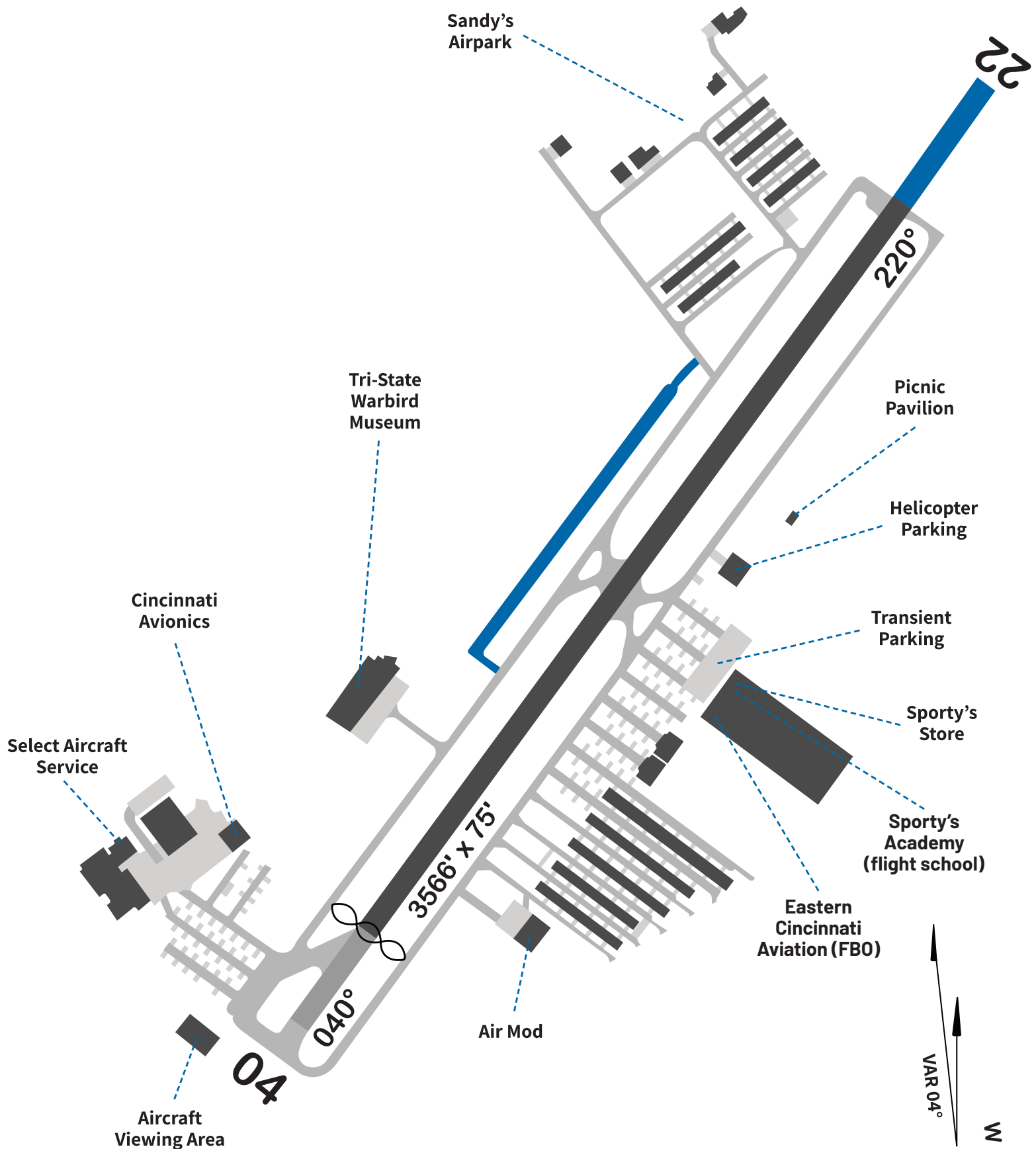
## COMBINE YOUR VISIT

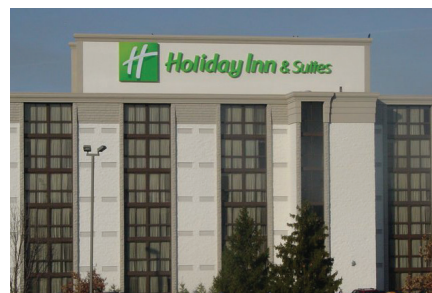
